New Baldor 1/4hp Buffer (Red)

Baldor is no longer making the 1/4hp buffer motor housing that it has for years. The new housing is the same size as the 1/2hp grinder. The buffer has 1/2" shafts and operates at 1800 rpm also the same as the original. The shafts have been extended by 1" on each end to make it easier to keep knives away from the housing. It is painted red, to avoid confusing it with the 1/2hp grinder.




Diamond Egg Bar Insert POSTED 6/17/20

Conrad welds a Diamond Egg Bar insert into a Kerckhaert Standard Max shoe he has shaped to a hind pattern.



Diamond Heart Bar Insert Demo POSTED 6/20/20

Conrad continues working through options with the Diamond Heart Bar insert, welded into a Kerckhaert Classic Roller front shoe.



Diamond Onion Heel Insert POSTED 6/22/20

Weld-In Toe and Collateral Inserts

Conrad works on the last two styles of inserts with the fabrication of the Diamond Toe and Collateral (branch) inserts. Using a Kerckhaert Standard Max shoe he has modified to a hind pattern, he welds in the insert that can be helpful for suspensory issues. He follows with the collateral (branch) insert welded into a Classic Roller front shoe.
